REFRESHMENT CONCESSION CARVERS RECREATION GROUND, RINGWOOD

Conditions of Tender

1. The concession takes place adjacent to skate park and the children's' play area of the Carvers Recreation Ground. The vehicle shall be parked in the position shown on the attached Plan and may not be moved elsewhere except with the prior written consent of the Town Council.
2. The concession is to be from 10am to 1pm on the 23 July, 27 July, 30 July, 3 August, 6 August, 10 August, 13 August, 17 August, 20 August, 24 August & 27 August when the children's play scheme is in operation and also on Monday 31 August and each Saturday and Sunday from 25 July 2009 to 6 September 2009. For the weekends and the Bank Holiday, the hours of operation may not commence before 10 am and should close no later than 7pm.
3. The refreshments should comprise ice creams, together with hot and cold non alcoholic drinks.
4. The concessionaire is responsible for providing the necessary litter bin(s) and removing them and any litter at the end of each day.
5. A key will be supplied for the opening of the main gate, at Southampton Road, for access. The concessionaire must lock the gate after entry and also lock it on departure.
6. The payment for the concession is required, in full, before it commences and is payable to the Ringwood Town Council at its offices at 'Greenways', 71 Christchurch Road, Ringwood, Hampshire, BH24 1DH.
7. The concessionaire's unit must be removed from the Recreation Ground each day.

8. The concessionaire will be required to take all necessary steps to ensure that in operating the concession, no nuisance is caused to other users of the Recreation Ground and adjoining residents and, in particular, will not allow music to be played so that it can be heard by the public.
9. The concessionaire should note that the Recreation Ground is let for cricket in the evenings, weekends and Bank Holidays. Under no circumstances shall the concessionaire encroach on or near the cricket playing area.
10. Applicants must provide evidence that they conform to all current and health and safety legislation and hold the necessary food hygiene certificates, further that they will undertake to keep abreast of any changes in the legislation and in a timely manner take the appropriate action in order to comply with such changes.
11. Applicants must carry employee (if appropriate) and public liability insurances and that in the event of any claim, arising from their activities, they will be deemed to be held liable except where it can be proved that Ringwood Town Council has been negligent in either its awarding of or managing of the contract. A copy of the policies and renewal certificates shall be provided for inspection by the Town Council prior to commencement of the concession.
12. The Town Council reserves the absolute right to terminate this concession with no rebate on the fee paid if the concessionaire contravenes any of the conditions contained in this document.
13. The Town Council does not bind itself to accept the highest or any tender.
