Re Bench – Parsonage Barn lane – Positioned Outside 5 Mount Pleasant Lane

We have lived at No5 Mount Pleasant Lane for nearly 5 years. Without exception every summer and early spring, we have endured, foul language and in a number of cases personal abuse & criminal damage, and not forgetting the use of our property as a public urinal, On two of those occasions we have had to call the police due to the abuse we had suffered.

We were advised by the police to write to the council and request its relocation or removal, and so finally I am following their advice before another summer of disturbances and worry.

I have a young family, and I am sure that you will appreciate my position as a responsible parent. Foul language is not something that I will tolerate from my own children!. Unfortunately, not all parents seem to take the same responsibility!, and to make things worse one of my children's windows face the bench. I do not see why they should be exposed to crude obscenities, at any time, and from youths (13 – 17) who's parent don't appear to care as to where there children are, what they are doing, especially at between 12.00 am – 3.00am in the morning and even earlier in the summer, when the nights are warmer.

Constantly, I am picking up litter beer & cider cans, bottles, burger rappers/containers etc from the side of my house, and I don't see why I should be exposed to this on a regular basis.

Last year an older couple in the bungalow across the road were verbally abused and I know Brian and Pam my next door neighbours have had problems.

My family and I have decided to move from our house because for a number of reasons, the local youths, the bench being just two of them! I really don't want the next family to endure the issues we have had.

I would really appreciate your help and understanding, and perhaps your influence in helping us to remedy this situation, and then at least we will be able to move on with a clear conscious.
