

FULL COUNCIL – 19TH DECEMBER 2007

OPEN SESSION

A resident of the town said that he took exception to two items in the Town Council's newsletter on the subject of development of the south west corner of the Furlong Car Park. The first being the inference that all people of or approaching retirement age would like to see the town stay as it is, and the second that people who regularly speak at public meetings and write letters to the press do not always represent the view of the majority of residents. He said that he had seen no letters of support for Option 1 in the local paper and contended that it was not just a vociferous few who were not in favour of development, as 835 people had voted against Option 1 – a clear majority.
