**COUNTY COUNCILLOR'S REPORT**

**HAMPSHIRE ACTION TEAM (HAT) – October 2009**

**Proposed Highway Works**

- Christchurch Road (B3347) – Highway drainage Oct – Dec 2009
- Christchurch Road (B3347) – Footway reconstruction October 2009
- Poplar Way (U121) - Footway reconstruction September 2009

**Area Programme (Reserve Schemes) 2009/10**

- Christchurch Road - informal pedestrian facility to be investigated
- Town Centre - possible implementation of pedestrian signage as a Parish Partnership Scheme

**Proposals to be Investigated**

- Southampton Road – Post 2009/10 if Stage 2 funding secured: amended parking restrictions/parking zone & one-way TRO
- Kings Arms Lane - one way southbound - experimental order to be Progressed as no objections from HCC & HA

**Safer Routes to School (sub Programme of the Capital Programme)**

- Ringwood School - on-site CCTV and improved lighting (to be submitted to Exec. Member – Environment for approval at a later date – approx. date September 2009)

**School Travel Plans**

- Ringwood Senior, Junior & Infant Schools and Poulner Junior & Primary Schools have submitted Final Travel Plans and been approved.

**Ringwood Bus Services**

- Wilts & Dorset Service X3 – the Sunday hourly service has been extended from summer only to throughout the year.

**Road Programme**

- HCC has committed an additional £2.4m for repairs to Class 'C' and unclassified roads throughout the County.

## **Streetlighting**

- A £225m 25-year project to replace County lighting is due to start at the beginning of 2010. All lighting 15 years or older is to be replaced during the first 5 years.
