Flying Flags

- 1. Introduction and reason for report
 - 1.1 In light of a recent change in guidance from central government, officers seek decisions from members about flag flying from the flag-pole in Gateway Square.

2. <u>Background, Options and Implications</u>

- 2.1 The normal practice of the Council has been to fly the Union Flag only on those days previously approved in respect of government buildings. The government recently issued revised guidance which allows and encourages the Union Flag to be flown from official buildings all year round.
- 2.2 There are other flags which could properly be flown but which the Council does not have at present. The more relevant of these are as follows:
 - The Flag of St. George
 - The Hampshire Flag
 - The Commonwealth Flag
 - The Armed Forces Day Flag
- 2.3 Flags are usually raised or lowered by a member of the grounds team and each movement typically takes about 60 minutes total staff time (including travelling). Flags wear out more quickly and therefore require replacement more frequently, the more they are flown.
- 3. Issues for decision and any recommendations
 - 3.1 Should the Union Flag be flown only on the days previously approved or all year round (except on days, if any, when other approved flags are flown)?
 - 3.2 Which other flags (if any) should the Council buy and fly on suitable days?
