REGRADING OF STAFF POSTS

Members considered the Town Clerk's report (*Confidential Annex A*), with recommendations arising from the Committee's previous consideration of the consultant's report on re-grading of staff posts (*S/0084 refers*).

Members concerns had been discussed with the consultant, and a number of options were presented for discussion.

Members agreed the revised pay scales would ensure that all staff were being paid a fair wage, consistent with the staffing structure and in line with councils of a similar size.

RESOLVED:

- That the consultant's recommendation to specify a four-point pay scale range for each post, linking pay progression to a new Performance Management Plan, be approved.

- 3) That the revised pay scales be backdated to 1st April 2022.
- 4) That no increments be awarded in 2023/24 in order to allow a new Performance Management Plan to be introduced.
- 5) That Cllrs Deboos, Haywood and Heron be appointed to an Appeals Panel to settle any appeals if required.
