C/6103 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

The Town Clerk reported that apologies for absence had been received from Cllrs Ford, Murphy and Rippon-Swaine.

C/6104 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were none declared at this time.

C/6105 MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

RESOLVED: That the minutes of the Meeting held on 31st January 2018, having been circulated, be approved and signed as a correct record.

C/6106 RECREATION, LEISURE AND OPEN SPACES COMMITTEE

Cllr Briers presented the minutes of the Recreation, Leisure and Open Spaces Committee meeting held on 7th February 2018.

OS/5749: Members considered the recommendation that the Council procure tenders for the overhaul and/or replacement of worn out play equipment with a provisional budget of £40,000. It was noted there was an allocated Provision to cover this sum.

RESOLVED: That the minutes of the Recreation, Leisure and Open Spaces Committee meeting held on 7th February 2018 be received and the recommendation therein be approved.

C/6107 PLANNING, TOWN & ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE

Cllr Treleaven presented the minutes of the Planning, Town & Environment Committee meeting held on 2nd February 2018.

RESOLVED: That the minutes of the Planning, Town & Environment Committee meeting held on 2nd February 2018 be received.

Cllr Heron joined the meeting at 7.05pm.

C/6108 POLICY & FINANCE COMMITTEE

Cllr Heron presented the minutes of the Policy & Finance Committee meeting held on 21st February 2018.

RESOLVED: That the minutes of the Policy & Finance Committee meeting held on 21st February 2018 be received.

C/6109 APPROVAL OF PAYMENTS

Members approved the list of payments from the Imprest account for January 2018, which had been omitted from the papers for the Policy & Finance Committee held on 21st February (*Annex A*). The following was noted:

- Notice of termination had been given to Suez for the refuse collection at the Cemetery in future skips would be used, which would result in a cost saving.
 The cost of the Ringwood North by-election was high as the Town Council was required to bear the total cost, including printing and postage of poll cards. Cllr Heron had previously proposed that in future poll cards should not be issued for by-elections. General election costs would be less as the costs were shared.
 The cost of telephony for Gateway includes the Town Council's share of the annual fee for the Hampshire Public Services Network (HPSN), which provides the internet connection for the building. It is not possible to renegotiate this fee as it is a requirement of the tri-party agreement for management of the building.
- **RESOLVED**: That the list of payments on the Imprest account, included in *Annex A*, be authorised. Cllrs Heron and Ward signed the report.

C/6110 THE PLACE WORKING PARTY

Following the resignation of Cllr Loose from The Place Working Party, there was a vacancy to fill.

RESOLVED: That Cllr Thierry be appointed to The Place Working Party.

C/6111 COMMUNICATIONS TO BE RECEIVED

The Town Mayor spoke of his disappointment in the poor state of repair of the roads and pavements in the town centre, and the missing barriers in Mansfield Road, despite having been promised on numerous occasions by Hampshire Highways that these issues would be dealt with. He was also concerned about other issues, such as the reinstatement of the

Bickerley Village Green, deterioration of the Old Town Hall, and lack of starter homes, all of which were outside of the Town Council's control. He said that the people who work so hard to make the Town great deserve more and better support from those bodies responsible.

C/6112 REPORTS FROM TOWN COUNCILLORS AND STUDENT ADVISORS

<u>Cllr Day</u> reported that he had attended the RAF Ibsley Memorial Service with the Town Mayor; he had asked the Deputy Town Clerk to request that Keep Clear markings on the town roundabouts be repainted as they had worn away and were being ignored by drivers; and was disappointed that SSE had taken no further action to install a street light in Kings Arms Lane.

<u>Cllr Treleaven</u> reported on works still outstanding by Hampshire Highways on drainage and flooding issues in the Crow area; and that he had attended the Blashford and Plumley Wood Local Liaison Group meeting, which discussed the impact on local communities of the quarrying carried out by Tarmac.

<u>Cllr Edge</u> reported that a new Police Community Support Officer (PCSO) had been assigned to Poulner, and there were already reports that people felt safer.

<u>Cllr O'Reilly</u> reported that she had attended the Forest Forge AGM and the performance report had been very encouraging; she had also attended the Western Escarpment Conservation Area Steering Group meeting and an item relating to its proposed action plan had been included on the agenda for the Planning, Town & Environment Committee on 2nd March.

<u>Cllr Ring</u> said that Members should support the Town Mayor's sentiments spoken earlier in the meeting, and there was general agreement. He had attended the National Park Authority South West Quadrant meeting, and highlighted grants available for community projects. Following a successful fundraising event by the Twinning Association, another event had been organised for 20th April – further details would follow. He encouraged Members to complete the Local Policing Community Priorities survey. He clarified that all income raised from events had been collected and handed over to the Town Council.

<u>Cllr Wiseman</u> wished to thank Mr & Mrs Atack, who had voluntarily been collecting litter from the verges in Moortown Lane.

<u>Rachel Carr</u> reported that the Student Advisors very much appreciated the Town Clerk and Deputy Town Clerk going in to the School the previous day and seeking their feedback and views on how the scheme could be improved. She asked if Students could complete the Policing Survey referred to earlier, and it was agreed to forward the link; this survey is open to all members of the community.

C/6113 REPORTS FROM COUNTY AND DISTRICT COUNCILLORS

<u>District Councillor Heron</u> reported that the District Council had now set the Council Tax for 2018/19, at £1,693.78 for an average band D property, an increase of £90.06 (5.62%).

<u>County Councillor Thierry</u> said that he could not defend Hampshire County Council in their failings to deliver on the issues that had been raised earlier. He said that he shared the frustrations of other councillors and felt that Ringwood was not being served as well it might be. He recommended that Cllr Rob Humby, the Executive Member for Highways, be invited to attend a future Full Council meeting and that assurance should be sought that matters would be addressed, with a firm commitment to include items in work programmes. The Town

Mayor suggested that he be invited to attend a walkabout prior to the meeting, so that he could see the issues for himself.
