Natural England will be funding the scheme by £8,000 which is to go toward improving access and interpretation to the river.

This leaves £43,000 to come from developers contributions.

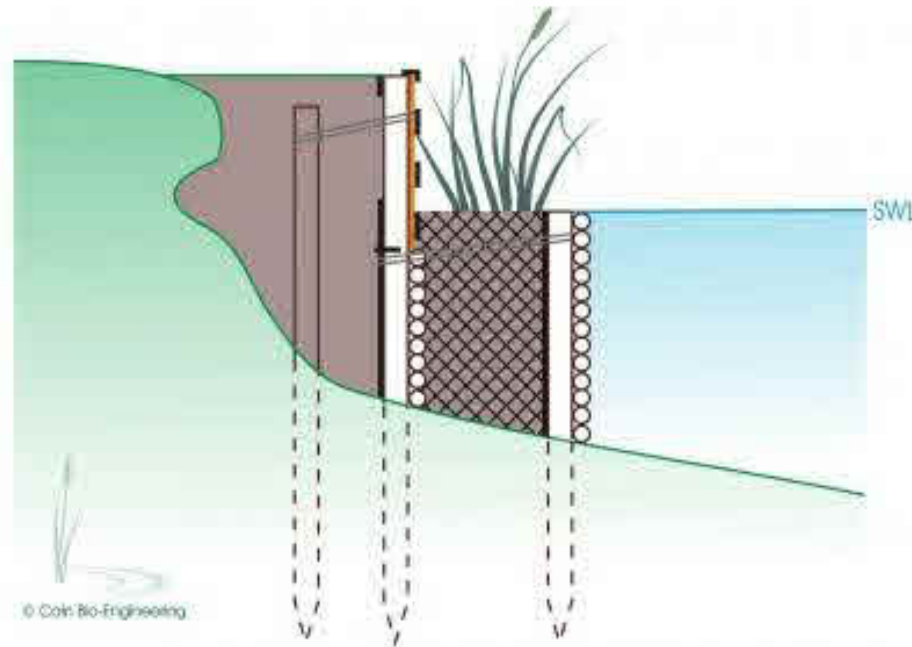


Proposals along river bank – illustrative panorama

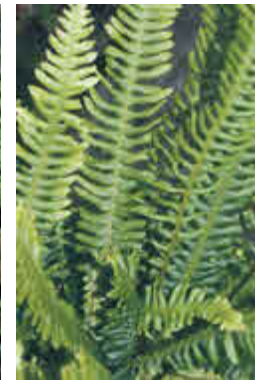

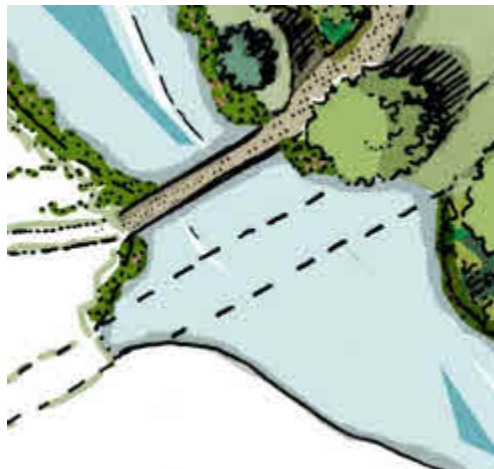
