CARVERS RECREATION GROUND/PAVILION

CONDITIONS OF HIRE

- 1. Entrance/exit to be via Southampton Road. A refundable deposit of £25 will be charged for the key to the gate and/or the Cricket Pavilion. Under no circumstances may a copy be made of either key.
- 2. The gate must be attended at all times when it is unlocked and only cricket players and their followers may be allowed to park on Carvers. The gate MUST be kept locked whenever it is unattended. Should the gate be left open or unlocked and unauthorised persons gain access, the hirer will be responsible for all costs reasonably incurred by the Council in securing their removal and any clean-up required of the area.
- 3. The Pavilion and the Cricket Square are to be left clean and tidy on departure.
- 4. Full payment for each booking (whether for a single let or for a series of lets) must be made in advance on receipt of invoice from the Council. Booking fees so paid in advance shall be refunded only in the case of single lets (not individual dates within a series of lets) if notice of cancellation is received at the Council office at least 48 hours in advance of the booking start time.
- 5. Reasonable care must be taken to avoid noise and other nuisance to local residents and users of other parts of Carvers Recreation Ground.
- 6. The hirer is responsible for managing use of the facilities safely. Ringwood Town Council, its officers, members, servants and agents shall not be responsible for loss or damage to property howsoever caused nor, to the extent permitted by law, for personal injury sustained as a result of the activities permitted by any booking.
