## **2.00pm Rock Choir**

'Rock Choir are a lively, fun-loving choir full of people who love to sing! We perform a wide variety of Pop, Rock and Motown songs from many eras. They are sure to get you up on your feet dancing and singing along!

### **3.00pm Scarlet Swing**

# Important information to help you enjoy the day

- **Entry to the event is free** but we welcome donations at the gate (card and cash accepted). 50% of the proceeds will be split between local charities. These are Spiral Blue, Ringwood United Charities and the Stable Family Home Trust.
- **There is no parking on site.** If you are local, please consider walking to the site. Otherwise, please use the main Town Centre car parks. New Forest District Council car parks in the town are FREE to park on Sunday 5 June.
- If you are walking from the Town Centre, please follow the signs and use the **Carvers Lane entrance** to the Recreation Ground rather than Southampton Road.
- We are using reusable plastic cups at the Charity Bar, run by the Round Table. Please return the glasses before you leave so that they can be used at future events. A deposit return point will be positioned midway between the exits or they can be handed in at the gates (no deposits can be returned at the gates).
- Well-behaved dogs are welcome, but please keep them on a lead.
- Many stalls will have card facilities but please bring cash as well
- The skate park and play area will be open as usual. The football goals will need to be removed.
- You are of course welcome to bring picnic blankets and camping chairs. If you are bringing sun shelters please be considerate - no gazebo sides and only small pop up tents. Please keep within the picnic area.
- If you have mobility issues and need help carrying chairs etc, please speak to the volunteers on the gate who will be able to assist.
- We will have bins on site but please take as much home with you as possible, especially anything which can be recycled.
- Please dismount bikes on site.
- Please take care with any glass (bottles etc) brought onto the site and take home if possible.
- Please be advised that filming and photography will be taking place at the event for publicity purposes.
